

# Recreational Vessel Courtesy Check (RVCC)

## ....at Reed Point Marina

The *Recreational Vessel Courtesy Check* program is an educational program being delivered on behalf of Transport Canada.

This spring, at your invitation, a trained representative from the Port Moody Power & Sail Squadron will board your boat and review the safety equipment that is legally required for the size of your vessel.

You will receive a list of any items that are either missing or in need of replacement.

**There is no penalty if you are not in compliance**

Once you have resolved any outstanding issues, the representative will return and issue you a decal that certifies that your vessel complies with Transport Canada requirements and, more importantly, you are properly equipped with the safety gear you will need in the event of an emergency.

This is a great opportunity to learn more about boating safety and make sure that you are ready to head out on the water.

The knowledge you gain from a courtesy check will help you to stay safe on the water.
